June is a vibrant and celebratory time in Hampton Roads, marked by graduations, Father's Day, the onset of summer, and, notably, Pride Month. This month, the LGBTQ+ community comes together with a variety of events that highlight unity and inclusivity. Key celebrations include Hampton Roads PrideFest, Pride at the Beach, and the Virginia Beach Pride Parade, drawing both locals and visitors to participate in the festivities.

Supporting the LGBTQ+ community in the region, the Hampton Roads Business Outreach (HRBOR) plays a significant role. As Virginia's first LGBTQ+ Chamber of Commerce, HRBOR's mission is to "advocate for Hampton Roads' LGBTQ+ businesses and professionals, and to create an inclusive welcoming environment in which to live, work, and grow." This mission is reflected in their various initiatives and partnerships throughout the year.

One of HRBOR's notable collaborations is with <u>Outlife757</u> Magazine to publish <u>Outguide757</u>, The Essential LGBTQ+ Resource for Coastal Virginia. This guide is a comprehensive resource featuring LGBTQ+ owned businesses, allied entrepreneurs, and various organizations that serve the community, fostering an environment of support and visibility.

HRBOR also addresses employment needs within the LGBTQ+ community. In March, they hosted Outwork757, Virginia's only LGBTQ+ career expo. This event is crucial for connecting LGBTQ+ job seekers with inclusive employers. Additionally, HRBOR held its third Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Roundtable for members and expo recruiters, further emphasizing its commitment to fostering diverse and inclusive workplaces.
